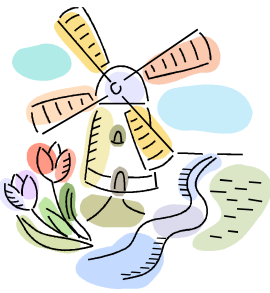

**PLEASE BE SAFE**

Thank you for your patience and cooperation with our new drop-off and pick-up procedures. Things have been proceeding pretty well. Please continue to practice safety in parking, vehicle speed, and in any other way that will prevent accidents at Fremont Christian School. Here is a quick review of our procedures:

**DROP-OFF**

Preschool—drop off and walk students to the classroom through the front doors of the elementary building (EB)  
 K – 5<sup>th</sup>—drop off students from the passenger side of the vehicle, so that they do not have to cross the street on Dayton Street, on the South side of the EB before 7:55; After 7:55 come in the circle drive at the consolidated building (CB) and drop off students at the elementary entrance behind the CB  
 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>—enter through the circle drive and drop off at the Middle School entrance behind the CB

**PICK-UP**

Preschool—park in front of the EB and come to the classroom and pick up your students  
 K – 1<sup>st</sup>—line up in the parking area and pick up your student in front of the EB  
 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>—enter through the circle drive, line up or park if you are entering the CB and pick up your student at the elementary or middle school entrance; **\*\*Please do not park in the line up area to talk with someone or wait for more than a couple of minutes for your students—the goal is to keep the traffic flowing\*\***
