### FOX'S FINDINGS

Just as He continues to work in His world and with all people scattered around the earth, He works in His people. He graces us with new growth, with beauty, and gives us nourishment. He is *Jehovah Jireh*, the Lord who provides. His grace is sufficient for each of us, for every person, and for the entire universe.
